Dentistry in China: Fast Facts

- According to the Ministry of Health, mainland China has about 38,000 registered dentists; Hong Kong has about 1800
- · Ratio of dentists to population:

China	1:33,000
Hong Kong	1:4000
USA	1:1600
Sweden	1:800

- In China, 50% of adults and 70% of children have decayed teeth, and more than 90% of people have periodontal disease
- · China would need to build 10 times as many dental hospitals as it has today, to match the coverage of dental treatment and protection found in developed countries
- The HKU Faculty of Dentistry has forged strong ties with mainland China, such as mutual collaborations with dental and stomatological schools in Beijing Shanghai, Guangzhou, Chengdu, Xian, and Wuhan
- Many HKU Faculty of Dentistry staff hold honorary appointments in mainland universities and editorships or memberships of editorial boards of mainland dental iournals
